Third Sunday after the Epiphany.** Gather together with one voice and heart to sing, pray and hear God's Word proclaimed. Hear the story of Jesus calling the fisherfolk Simon and Andrew, James and John to follow him "to seek other seas." How is God calling you to serve in new ways? - **History Event #1. Thanks to the 30 or so folks who participated last Sunday in our lively conversations about the journeys traveled by our two former congregations in the years before we became one!** It was a joy to listen to stories, recall fond memories and learn from one another. Stay tuned for the **second session of our "History Event" on Sunday, January 31**, via Zoom, shortly after worship. Our Event Team (Linda Kapitan, Dawn Tiedemann and Loraine Brown) is now compiling information and perspectives gained from last Sunday, so we can share learnings and think together about how our histories can contribute to our common future.
- **Annual Congregational Meeting set for Sunday, February 7, following worship.** We will gather together to reflect back on 2020 and the challenges and accomplishments we experienced as a congregation on the verge of a new beginning. And even more we will look ahead to the months and to the year ahead as we continue to build and strengthen our life together as Christ the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church. The outline for steps leading toward the calling of a new pastor for the congregation will be presented. - **Sunday Zoom Worship to continue in coming weeks.** At the January 18 Congregation Council meeting it was decided that we continue on our current path of putting the health of one another as a top priority by worshipping via Zoom in the next few weeks. This path will again be reconsidered at the Council's next meeting

on February 15. We know this is not the ideal path but continue to see it as the best of the imperfect choices we face. And we are confident we are inching closer to the day when we will gather in person again.

- And speaking of gathering together in person for worship, as we anticipate that day, you should know that the **planned renovations of the worship space at the future Christ the Good Shepherd Church facility are well underway.** New carpeting (a beautiful red) has been laid. Space has been created for the baby grand piano (now in the current music room) to be placed in the church nave next to the organ. A rear pew has been removed to provide space for wheelchairs. The altar area has been slightly renovated to allow for the altar to be free standing and the worship leaders to face the congregation. Also, the church office has received a new carpet.
