- **Join the community of faith for worship this Sunday, March 28, Sunday of the Passion/Palm Sunday, 10:00 a.m.** As we begin the week of the holiest days of our life together in Christ, we look forward to worshipping together in person.
 - **Blessing of the Palms. The Passion story according to St. Mark. Holy Communion.**
 - **Worship will be outdoors (weather permitting) in the courtyard at our facility at 600 Shepard Ave., Hamden.** Since the forecast seems to change a little every day, hope for positive shifts for Sunday. This will allow us to accommodate as many who want to come and be together for the first time since last fall's outdoor services. Bring lawn chairs if you can. Folding chairs will be available. All appropriate COVID protocols will be observed.

 - **Worship will move inside if weather doesn't cooperate.** Reservations will be required as we will have to restrict seating so as to keep to safe distancing. Capacity will be around 40.
