Notice of Special Congregational Meeting

On Sunday, August 8, 2021 following the 9:30 a.m. service, a special congregational meeting will be conducted to elect a pastor of the church to serve this congregation. A representative of the Office of the Bishop, Rev. Kari Henkelmann Keyl, will preside at the meeting.

The candidate being recommended by the Congregation Council will lead the service and preach on that date. Following the service, the meeting will be held during which a congregational vote on the candidate will take place by paper ballot.

A two-thirds majority is required for the election of a pastor, and no absentee ballots are permitted. There will also be a vote on the recommended compensation package for the pastor, which may be decided by voice or hand vote, and requires a simple majority. No other items of business may be conducted at this meeting.

On Saturday, August 7, 2021 from 2-4pm, we will hold a ***Meet & Greet*** at Christ the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church to give the congregation the opportunity to meet the candidate and ask questions.
